PREPARING FOR GROUP CONFERENCES Thursday 10th October 2024

This workshop will support participants to:

- revise diagnostic and preparation skills;
- analyse combinations of disputehandling, conflict-management, and change-management techniques that can help resolve complex situations;
- explore examples of case management to determine the most appropriate process or combination of processes;
- practise preparation skills in small- and large-group exercises.

MANAGING COMPLEX CASES Friday 11th October 2024

This workshop will support participants to:

- examine how to adapt group conferencing and other restorative practices when dealing with more complex cases (including cases involving family violence, sexual assault, or organisational issues);
- review administrative arrangements that support therapeutic outcomes;
- revise and practise group conference facilitation skills in small- and large-group exercises.

The training meets the Best Practice Standards developed by the Australian Association of Restorative Justice (AARJ) for training in Group Conference facilitation.
