This workshop will support participants to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ revise <i>diagnostic</i> and <i>preparation</i> skills;▪ analyse combinations of dispute-handling, conflict-management, and change-management techniques that can help resolve complex situations;▪ explore examples of case management to determine the most appropriate process or combination of processes;▪ practise <i>preparation</i> skills in small- and large-group exercises.	This workshop will support participants to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ examine how to adapt group conferencing and other restorative practices when dealing with more complex cases (including cases involving family violence, sexual assault, or organisational issues);▪ review administrative arrangements that support therapeutic outcomes;▪ revise and practise group conference <i>facilitation</i> skills in small- and large-group exercises.

The training meets the Best Practice Standards developed by the Australian Association of Restorative Justice (AARJ) for training in Group Conference facilitation.
